

Rules and Regulations for Tennis

1. All the games will conduct under the current official rules of the International Tennis Federation (ITF).
2. Methods of scoring will be in a set. The set methods, either the “Advantage Set” or the “Tie-break Set” will be used for the scoring methods. The one to be use will be announce in advance of the event.
3. A match can be played to the best of 3 sets (a player/team needs to win 2 set to win the match).
4. The choice of ends and the choice to be server or receiver in the first game shall be decided by toss before the warm-up starts.
5. Coaching is not allowed during the match time.
6. The referee is the final authority on all questions of tennis law and the referee’s decision is final.
7. The referee may also stop or suspend play in the case of darkness, weather or adverse court conditions. When play is suspended for darkness, this should be done at the end of a set, or after an even number of games have been played in the set in progress. After a suspension in play, the score and position of player’s on-court in the match shall stand when the match resumes.

*Management decision is the final decision & has the right to make changes if needed
